HOUSE CRIMINAL JUSTICE COMMITTEE PASSES BILL TO CLOSE BACKGROUND CHECK LOOPHOLE

CONCORD, NEW HAMPSHIRE – Today the House Criminal Justice Committee voted 10-9 to recommend passage of [HB 109](#), which closes the background check loophole. **Representative Katherine Rogers (D-Concord)**, prime sponsor of the legislation, released the following statement:

“We have seen that conducting background checks is an effective tool to preventing guns from being in the hands of people who are prohibited from owning them. Closing the background check loophole is a common sense solution that will make the people of the granite state safer.”
