HOUSE UPHOLDS SENATE'S STRONG BIPARTISAN SUPPORT OF BAIL REFORM LEGISLATION

CONCORD, NEW HAMPSHIRE – The House of Representatives voted today to pass [SB 314](#), bipartisan bail reform legislation. **Representative Renny Cushing (D-Hampton), Chair of the House Criminal Justice and Public Safety Committee**, released the following statement:

“I commend the dedicated, bipartisan efforts on SB 314 which led to the strong vote today in the House. The bail reform passed last session brought about pivotal changes to the system and this legislation builds on those efforts.”

“By providing judges more discretion and greater consideration when determining if a person presents a danger to themselves or others and addressing concerns about people who repeatedly fail to appear after being released, this legislation brings further clarification to last year’s reform.”

“I applaud the Criminal Justice committee for listening to the experiences of all stakeholders to strengthen last year’s bail reform. This legislation represents a bipartisan compromise at its finest.”
