SENATE VOTES TO PASS BACKGROUND CHECK LEGISLATION

CONCORD, NEW HAMPSHIRE – The New Hampshire Senate voted 13-10 today to pass [HB 109, closing background check loopholes](#). **House Majority Leader Doug Ley (D-Jaffrey)** released the following statement:

“Conducting background checks is a proven, effective tool in keeping guns out of the hands of people who are prohibited from owning them. Over 80% of Granite Staters support closing the background check loophole as a common sense solution that will make the people of our state safer. I thank the Senate for their strong vote today and encourage Governor Sununu to stand up for public safety in New Hampshire and sign HB 109 into law.”
