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BILL AUTHORIZING HR PROFESSIONAL TO HANDLE WORKPLACE HARASSMENT COMPLAINTS IN GENERAL COURT SIGNED INTO LAW

CONCORD, NEW HAMPSHIRE –Today, Governor Sununu signed [SB 235](#), authorizing an independent human resources professional to handle sexual harassment complaints in the general court. **House Majority Leader Doug Ley (D-Jaffrey)** released the following statement:

“Codifying this sexual harassment policy in law creates a new non-partisan structure to address complaints in the General Court. This legislation sends an important message to members of the legislature, State House employees, and members of the public that harassment will not be tolerated.”

“In addition to this legislation, the House has taken strides this year to address the reality of sexual harassment and discrimination in the workplace, including hosting two comprehensive workplace harassment trainings for legislators and staff. I am grateful that the safety, inclusion, and comfort of all people who work and visit the General Court has been a top priority of the legislature this session, culminating in SB 235 becoming law today.”
