INDEPENDENT REDISTRICTING PROPOSAL PASSES HOUSE

CONCORD, NEW HAMPSHIRE –Today, the New Hampshire House voted [224-141](#) to pass [SB 8](#), establishing an independent redistricting commission in New Hampshire. **Representative Marjorie Smith (D-Durham)** released the following statement:

“Removing partisan politics from the redistricting process is very important to the people of New Hampshire. Support for independent redistricting proposals has grown in the legislature because voters have made clear that fair elections are critical to their trust in government. Establishing fair districts is a nonpartisan issue, supported across the political spectrum. I am encouraged by the bipartisan support for this legislation today, and I hope that Governor Sununu reconsiders his opposition to independent redistricting.”
