HOUSE VOTES TO BACK INDEPENDENT REDISTRICTING COMMISSION

CONCORD, NEW HAMPSHIRE – The House of Representatives voted [218-123](#) today to pass [HB 706](#), which creates an independent redistricting commission. **Representative Marjorie Smith (D-Durham)**, prime sponsor of the legislation, released the following statement:

“I am absolutely thrilled by the House’s strong, bipartisan vote today to support independent redistricting. Elections should be won and lost on ideas and values, not gerrymandered districts. By ensuring that voters will pick their politicians, not the other way around, this bill will enhance voter trust in the election process.
