HOUSE-PASSED BILLS INCREASE EDUCATION FUNDING AND PROVIDE PROPERTY TAX RELIEF

CONCORD, NEW HAMPSHIRE –Today the House of Representatives passed [HB 623](#), which freezes tax cuts to large out-of-state businesses and [HB 686](#), which cuts interest and dividend taxes for over 4,500 Granite Staters while ensuring that the State is increasing funding for education and providing immediate property tax relief. **Representative Doug Ley (D-Jaffrey)** issued the following statement:

“All across New Hampshire, families are looking for two things; property tax relief and a quality education for every young Granite Stater regardless of zip code. For almost a decade, state cuts to public education have increasingly resulted in the downshifting of cost burdens to local property taxpayers. Unsustainable and unpredictable property tax increases have placed undue stress on New Hampshire families, making future planning impossible and even forcing some families from their homes. This legislation recognizes it is time for the state to keep its promise to its citizens.”
