HOUSE BUDGET ADDS FUNDING FOR INTERNET CRIMES AGAINST CHILDREN TASK FORCE

CONCORD, NEW HAMPSHIRE – Today, the House added funding for the Internet Crimes Against Children Fund (ICAC). **House Majority Leader Doug Ley (D-Jaffrey)** released the following statement:
