HOUSE PASSES LEGISLATION TO ESTABLISH CHILDREN'S SYSTEM OF CARE

CONCORD, NEW HAMPSHIRE – The House of Representatives voted today to pass [SB 14-FN](#), establishing a statewide mobile crisis response for children and a children's system of care. **Representative Doug Ley (D-Jaffrey)** released the following statement:

"The passage of SB 14 today is an important measure to bring the goals of the 10-Year Mental Health Plan to fruition. By laying out a clear plan for case management and establishing an advisory committee to monitor the system of care, this bill implements critical aspects of the 10-Year Mental Health plan. The mobile crisis response and stabilization services included in this legislation will promptly address the mental health needs of Granite State children, reducing child protection costs in the future. A comprehensive plan for children's system of care should be a priority for this state, and I am pleased by the bipartisan vote today to take the health and safety of New Hampshire's children seriously."
