### **HOUSE VOTES TO ELIMINATE POLL TAXES**

**CONCORD, NEW HAMPSHIRE** – The House of Representatives voted [215-138](#) today to pass [SB 67](#), which clarifies the definition of “resident” to protect voters from payment of onerous fees to the state. **House Majority Leader Doug Ley (D-Jaffrey)** released the following statement:

“This bill is about fairness and protecting the right of all eligible voters in New Hampshire. Requiring people who already have a valid driver’s license to purchase a new one simply because they exercised their right to vote is the very definition of a poll tax.”

“Last term, Republicans in the legislature passed restrictive voting laws to justify Donald Trump’s outrageous excuses for losing New Hampshire. It is time to put the people of New Hampshire above the ego of Donald Trump. I remind Governor Sununu that voting rights are more important than acting as a shill for the president.”
