## **VETO OF CLEAN EMISSIONS LEGISLATION STIFLES EFFORT TO COMBAT CLIMATE CHANGE**

**CONCORD, NEW HAMPSHIRE** – House Majority Leader **Doug Ley (D-Jaffrey)** released the following statement in response to Governor Sununu’s veto of [SB 275](#), requiring that all of the state’s motor vehicles will be zero emissions vehicles by the year 2039:

“The governor’s veto of SB 275 makes clear that he has no interest in bringing New Hampshire closer to a clean energy future. This veto, in combination with the vetoes of HB 365 and SB 72, prove once again that the governor does not understand the threat posed by climate change. New Hampshire’s progress in combatting climate change is being held back by the governor’s enthrallment with the fossil fuel industry.”
