### **BILL TO EXPAND COMMUNITY SOLAR PARTICIPATION BY LOW TO MODERATE INCOME RESIDENTS SIGNED INTO LAW**

**CONCORD, NEW HAMPSHIRE** – Today, Governor Sununu signed [Senate Bill 165](#), which aims to increase access to net metering community solar projects for low to moderate income customers.

Representative **Howard Moffett (D-Canterbury)** released the following statement:

“Our state’s solar market should be developed in a way that benefits everyone. Senate Bill 165, the “Low-Income Community Solar Act of 2019,” builds off previous legislation by helping low to moderate income residents to benefit from community solar projects.”

“Through collaboration with the governor’s office on an amendment that aligns with bipartisan priorities to find ways that low income residents can more fully participate in renewable energy projects, this legislation enjoyed bipartisan support in both the House and Senate. I’m happy the governor decided to sign SB 165 into law, and I’m encouraged to know that we are working to incentivize developers to bring renewable solar to low income customers.”
