HOUSE PASSES SECURE MODERN ACCURATE REGISTRATION TECHNOLOGY (SMART) ACT

CONCORD, NEW HAMPSHIRE –Today, the New Hampshire House of Representatives voted 202-146 to pass [SB 7](#), the Secure Modern Accurate Registration Technology (SMART) Act. The bill will now return to the Senate for concurrence on House changes. **House Majority Leader Doug Ley (D-Jaffrey)**, released the following statement:

“As the first-in-the-nation primary state, it is imperative that our voter registration system is secure, accurate, and accessible. This bill improves our election process by utilizing Help America Vote Act funds to implement automatic voter registration, which has already been adopted in all other New England states. Access to elections is the foundation of democracy, and this bill strengthens that foundation in the Granite State.”
