HOUSE PASSES BILL TO INVEST IN ENERGY EFFICIENCY

CONCORD, NEW HAMPSHIRE – Today the House passed [HB 1496](#), which would rededicate a portion of the Energy Efficiency Fund derived from RGGI to energy efficiency programs. **Representative John Mann (D-Alstead)** released the following statement:
