HOUSE PASSES BILL TO STEM BIG MONEY IN POLITICS

CONCORD, NEW HAMPSHIRE – Today, the House passed [HB 1525](#) which would require organizations that spend money on elections to register with the State. **Representative Connie Lane (D-Concord)**, prime sponsor of the legislation, released the following statement:

“When money is being spent on election to clearly support or defeat a candidate Granite Staters deserve to know who is spending that money. HB 1525 is designed to close a loophole that allows groups that are clearly spending money on elections to spend that money in secret. Having a transparent election system is critical to ensuring faith in our elections process and HB1525 helps us accomplish that goal.”
