HOUSE REPUBLICANS BLOCK BIPARTISAN 10-YEAR HIGHWAY PLAN

House Republicans continued their partisan obstruction of legislative business by blocking the bipartisan House Bill 2020, the 10-year Highway Plan. After the vote, **Representative John Cloutier (D-Claremont), Chair of the House Public Works and Highways Committee** released the following statement:

“The 10-year Highway Plan, which was blocked from consideration by House Republicans today, is critical to the long-term planning of New Hampshire’s roadways and transportation infrastructure. This plan contains items that benefit communities across New Hampshire, including funding to remove the tollbooth in Merrimack. Republican leaders Dick Hinch and Jeanine Notter, who both represent Merrimack, apparently care more about blindly blocking Democrats than fixing our roads and removing the Merrimack tolls.”
