HOUSE REPUBLICANS BLOCK DISCUSSION ON BIPARTISAN NET METERING LEGISLATION

Today, House Republicans voted to block consideration of House Bill 1218, bipartisan legislation that will encourage the development of renewable energy in New Hampshire. After the vote **Representative Clyde Carson (D-Warner), Chair of the House Municipal and County Government Committee**, released the following statement:

“Net metering policies similar to HB1218 have had a history of strong bipartisan support in the New Hampshire House. This bill represents a significant amount of work by two House Policy committees, municipalities, and businesses to create compromise legislation to expand net metering in New Hampshire.”

“By voting to not suspend the rules for House Bill 1218, House Republicans blocked even discussing this legislation. It is discouraging to see that they continue to be more interested in obstructing all legislative business than having an open and honest discussion about policy that is so important to towns, municipalities, businesses, and citizens across the state.
