HOUSE REPUBLICANS COMMIT TO OBSTRUCTION

CONCORD, NH -- Today at the House Rules Committee meeting, House Republicans refused to agree to a change in rules that would allow the New Hampshire House of Representatives to finish its work this year. **Majority Leader Doug Ley (D-Jaffrey) released the following statement:**

“Two things are clear today -- Republicans have no interest in an efficient and responsive government and are trying to use further tax cuts for large business as a quid pro quo for allowing the House to finish its work. We understand that businesses have been hit hard by the COVID-19 pandemic and are working to determine the most effective ways to help our small businesses rebound and return to full strength.
