HOUSE REPUBLICANS UNDERCUT PROCESS IN PARTISAN VOTE TO BLOCK LEGISLATIVE PROGRESS

Today, House Republicans banded together to obstruct the House from extending its rules, effectively killing the 36 bills on the calendar today and blocking the over 200 Senate Bills waiting to transfer over to the House. After this highly partisan and political vote, **House Majority Leader Doug Ley (D-Jaffrey)** released the following statement:

“Today showed that Republicans will do all they can to exploit this pandemic for raw political gain. By blocking revised House deadlines, which were necessitated by COVID-19 and the state of emergency, Republicans are saying ‘no’ to the very concept of doing their job.

Democrats have offered proposal after proposal to benefit Granite Staters and our communities. Republicans have shown by their actions that they have no constructive ideas. Instead of engaging in bipartisan discussion to benefit the people of New Hampshire, Republicans chose to simply stop working.”
