#### **HOUSE PASSES PROPERTY TAX RELIEF LEGISLATION**

**CONCORD, NEW HAMPSHIRE** – Today, the House of Representatives voted 208-165 to pass Senate Bill 102 over objections from the House Republicans. Following the vote **Representative Marjorie Porter (D-Hillsborough), Ranking Democrat on the House Municipal and County Government Committee**, released the following statement:

“Senate Bill 102 is a good, enabling policy that will create property tax relief incentives aimed at helping our communities and citizens. It allows municipalities to adopt property tax exemptions for renewable generation and energy storage systems if they decide to. SB 102 also helps to incentivize the repair and rehabilitation of unused or underused residential units in order to increase the amount of available housing. These changes will help address our state’s housing shortage and move us towards increased renewable energy usage, all while putting money back in the pockets of our constituents.”
