HOUSE REPUBLICANS CONTINUE TO LEGISLATE DANGEROUS MISINFORMATION ABOUT COVID-19 VACCINE

CONCORD, NEW HAMPSHIRE – This morning, Republicans in the House Labor Committee passed an arguably non-germane amendment that has the effect of calling into question the safety of the Covid-19 vaccine. Following this stunt, **Deputy Democratic Leader David Cote (D-Nashua)** released the following statement:

“On two separate occasions in different committees this week, House Republicans have tried to tack completely non-germane amendments onto otherwise good legislation to push conspiracy theories about the COVID-19 vaccines.

In so doing, House Republicans have chosen to associate themselves with irrational ideas which discourage vaccination against a pandemic that has killed nearly 600,000 Americans to date.

Our business community has persevered through the pandemic by taking sensible actions to protect their employees and customers, and deserve the freedom to continue making those decisions.”
