CACR 32: DISTURBING, UNCONSTITUTIONAL, UNPATRIOTIC

CONCORD, NEW HAMPSHIRE – Today, the New Hampshire House voted to stop CACR 32, a constitutional amendment that would declare New Hampshire's independence from the United States of America. **Acting Democratic Leader David Cote (D-Nashua)** released the following statement:

“While it is certainly and unequivocally a good thing this constitutional amendment did not pass, it is shameful that it even came to this. The fact that this bill was even debated on the floor is a disturbing window into the current state of the Republican Party. Especially, equating this to the former Soviet Union and the conflict in Ukraine is despicable and disrespectful to millions suffering from this unprecedented invasion.”

“As representatives, we took an oath of office to uphold the United States Constitution. It is unconscionable that there are members of this body that will openly support leaving this country we all love. Some members need a lesson on the Constitution and patriotism.”
