**HOUSE REPUBLICANS KILL BILL TO GUARANTEE EMPLOYEES MEAL AND BATHROOM
BREAKS**

CONCORD, NEW HAMPSHIRE – Today, Republicans in the New Hampshire House voted to block [HB 1076](#), a bill to implement provisions regulating productivity quotas in workplaces. **Prime Sponsor of the legislation, Rep. Joshua Adjutant (D-Enfield)**, released the following statement:

“Today, without even allowing for debate, House Republicans preemptively killed a bill that would have reigned in the draconian productivity quota system that Big Tech companies use that force their workers to urinate in bottles, a practice so common at Amazon that in 2021, the company had to publicly apologize for denying it happens. Republican officials often complain about Big Tech as a cultural crutch, but when there's an opportunity to protect their employees, most Republicans are nowhere to be found. Democrats will continue to fight against the gradual reductions and ever-expanding loopholes in guaranteed labor rights, such as meal, rest room, and bathroom breaks. This language will be back before this House as soon as this year.”
