**DEMOCRATIC LEADER RESPONDS TO REPORT OF DOUBLE VOTING BY GOP
CONGRESSIONAL CANDIDATE**

CONCORD, NEW HAMPSHIRE – Today, the Associated Press reported that former Trump aide Matt Mowers, a 2020 and 2022 New Hampshire Congressional candidate, voted in presidential primary elections in two states in 2016. **House Democratic Leader Rep. David E. Cote (D-Nashua)** released the following statement:

“Republicans like to project about election ‘integrity’ as an excuse to pass increasingly draconian voting laws yet whenever actual cases of election fraud are discovered, they inevitably involve partisan Republicans themselves. The NH GOP has worked overtime to restrict absentee ballot access and intimidate voters with confusing registration forms, all while blocking the type of information sharing agreement that would prevent the fraud committed by Matt Mowers.

This disqualifying episode should come as little surprise. It is simply another reminder that Republican efforts to restrict voting in the name of ‘integrity’ are nothing more than hollow attempts to rig elections in their favor.”
