**HOUSE REPUBLICANS CONTINUE TO PUSH UNDESIRABLE RADICAL CHANGES  
TO CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICTS**

**CONCORD, NEW HAMPSHIRE** – Today, the House of Representatives voted 179-159 to pass SB 200 with an amendment included which reapportions Congressional Districts. **House Democratic Leader Rep. David E. Cote (D-Nashua)** released the following statement:

“The people of New Hampshire, including the governor, have made clear that radical changes to our Congressional districts are not desired or necessary. As Democrats have repeatedly proposed, the population of our districts can be equalized by moving just one town from CD 1 to CD 2.

The map passed by the House GOP today shifts over 550,000 Granite Staters from one district to another, continuing to ignore the governor and the public by plowing forward with districts gerrymandered to benefit one Republican Congressional candidate. Democrats will continue presenting fair, competitive districts as this process continues because that’s what the people of New Hampshire deserve.”
