REPUBLICAN CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICTS REMAIN UNACCEPTABLE
Democratic Proposal is Most Logical, Least Disruptive

CONCORD, NEW HAMPSHIRE – Today, the House Special Committee on Redistricting voted to pass SB 200, which was amended to include changes to Congressional Districts. **House Democratic Leader Rep. David E. Cote (D-Nashua)** released the following statement:

“Democrats continue to offer logical districts that retain the competitiveness Granite Staters want in Congressional races. The Democratic proposal retains our current districts, only moving one town to address population changes over the last decade, and respects the concepts that of accountability and competitiveness that are required to gain Governor Sununu’s support.

Governor Sununu has already said the map passed by Republicans today, which moves nearly half the state from one district to another, is unacceptable. Instead of continuing to push an obviously partisan proposal that is DOA, it is time for Republicans to come to the table and support the competitive, logical, undisruptive map that Democrats will offer again next week.”
