**GOP-PASSED DISTRICTS WOULD REDUCE COMPETITIVENESS IN CONGRESSIONAL  
ELECTIONS**

**CONCORD, NEW HAMPSHIRE** – Today, the House of Representatives voted 176-171 to pass SB 200, which reapportions Congressional districts. **House Democratic Leader Rep. David E. Cote (D-Nashua)** released the following statement:

“Here we go again. Republicans voted to pass gerrymandered congressional districts for the third time this year, this time displacing nearly a quarter of our citizens to create an artificial partisan advantage.

If the districts that passed today are signed into law, most voters will lose their influence as their representatives will be determined by partisan primary voters. This is wrong and unnecessary. There is no legitimate reason to make our Congressional districts less competitive and I hope the Governor vetoes this legislation.
